CBMC exists to present Jesus Christ to business and professional men and then equip them to carry out the great commission in their family, community and workplace. We have listed below the formats CBMC Mid-Atlantic has used throughout 2011 to carry out our mission and some numbers which will give you a picture of the depth and extent of the ministry.

CBMC men were involved in **21 Outreach Events** across the area with over **1500** business men and women hearing the gospel from fellow businessmen, followed by an invitation to connect with Jesus themselves and begin their own personal relationship with Him.

There are **16 Active Outreach Teams** meeting weekly across our region of Eastern PA, New Jersey and Delaware. Outreach teams are groups of men gathering for practical, workplace focused bible study, equipping, and prayer for each other and lost friends. In 2011, we started a new team in Southern Delaware. **140+** men across our region are involved in outreach on a weekly basis.

We currently have **3 active CBMC Forums teams** and are **getting ready to birth a 4th team!** These are teams of 5-8 Christian business owners that meet monthly to act as each other's Board of Advisors. They learn what the Bible says about being a steward of God's resources and being a spiritual shepherd in their businesses. One new member recently said, "Being part of CBMC has changed the way I look at my business. Instead of using my business to just 'fund' my ministry, I'm now seeing how I can use my business to BE my ministry".

One new type of team was started this year called **Work Place Leaders**. It is a once a month, 2 hour lunch meeting for men that want to have a confidential time to discuss how to apply God's word in the work place and to connect with other men in a more personal venue. Our first team is meeting in King of Prussia.

We had **2 area leadership meetings** in 2011 where leaders from across our area gathered to receive training, connect with each other and learn about all the new things CBMC is coming out with plus allow for some focused prayer time for each other. What exciting times these are!

We had **4 men graduate** with Coaching Certificates from the **CBMC Leadership Coach Training program**. 4 of the men from last year's class continued on with their training this year to receive more intensive training and performed actual 'observed coaching'. These men are now using their training to help other men grow and to positively impact their relationships with their own families.

A group of nearly **20** men from our area traveled to Gettysburg, PA to attend the **CBMC East Coast Men's Conference**. Here they connected with CBMC men from all over the nation to get re-energized and trained by the many powerful speakers and workshops. Scott was actively involved as a co-leader of the workshop planning team for 6 months leading up to the event where he partnered with his peer from New England to plan, schedule, staff and oversee the **16+ workshops**. In the Fall, a group of CBMCers and their friends gathered at the Harvey Cedars Bible Conference Center for the **CBMC Mid-Atlantic Fall Men's Retreat**, a powerful weekend of great teaching on living in the resurrection power of Jesus Christ. It was a moving weekend capped off by **2 men being baptized** in the Bay!

This Summer we changed up the Family Time Out program and moved the venue to NorthBay Retreat Center in Northeast, MD. At **Family Adventure Camp**, there were lots of active things for the young and "young at heart" including a large outdoor swimming pool, kayaking, motor boats and zip-lines. There was also age appropriate teaching for the children and powerful teaching on building our marriages for the adults. All there were impacted and the NorthBay facility got great reviews!

In addition to all the official events, there were are also many picnics, couples dinners, discipleship meetings, and prayer meetings. The cumulative effect of all of this is that more than **1,700 business men and women were reached with the gospel of Christ or encouraged to grow in their daily walk with Him through the ministry of CBMC Mid-Atlantic during 2011.**
